The English Teacher will inspire, encourage and help students to become fluent in the English language. S/he will:

- a. Be fully conversant with the English language, particularly grammar , including English language teaching up to secondary / higher secondary level
- b. Make English classes interesting and active and inspire students to perform
- c. Interact with students to encourage confidence and English fluency in everyday life
- d. Manage facilities and learning resources, including a language laboratory, such that students can evolve through project work and experiential learning, as well as formal methods
- e. Make linkages and take students on an intellectual journey from the classroom into the outside world
- f. Make extensive use of IT in English language teaching and enable students to independently use IT in learning the English language
- g. Conduct lesson planning, manage homework, and undertake student assessments in line with best practice
- h. Lead English-related extra-curricular activities, such as helping to organise clubs (e.g. film club).
- i. Participate in various school activities and carry out other responsibilities as and when required by the management
- j. Support the school in providing English language training to other teachers and support staff
- k. Be responsible for English language development of both the school and hostel students, and actively participate in school and hostel activities
- l. Be responsible for overseeing the annual production of the school magazine

S/he will lead departmental management meetings and will advise the school on English language learning. Play a major role in promoting and nurturing the vision of DPKI as an English medium school.
