

## Science Teacher

### JOB DESCRIPTION

The Science Teacher will inspire, encourage and help students to independently explore and understand the world around them through science. S/he will:

- a. Be fully conversant with Science up to post-graduate level, including latest developments in the field and science teaching up to secondary / higher secondary level
- b. Make science exciting, dynamic and relevant – a subject that students will want to learn
- c. Develop the science laboratory as a lively place where students will want to be
- d. Interact with students to encourage their active engagement with science, technology and engineering
- e. Inspire young people to be inquisitive and to think about the world they live in
- f. Help them to use equipments such as microscopes, telescopes etc.
- g. Manage facilities and learning resources such that students can evolve through project work and experiential learning, as well as formal methods
- h. Make extensive use of the laboratory in enriching science learning for the students
- i. Make linkages between the classroom and the extend and take students on a journey of exploration and finding answers independently
- j. Make extensive use of IT and enable students to use IT independently in science learning
- k. Conduct lesson planning, manage homework, and undertake student assessments in line with best practice
- l. Lead science-related extra-curricular activities, such as organising a Science Club
- m. Pay particular attention to encouraging girls to excel in science learning and participate in the abovementioned activities
- n. Participate in various school activities and carry out other responsibilities as and when required by the management
- o. Be responsible for science knowledge development of both the school and hostel students, and actively participate in school and hostel activities

S/he will lead departmental meetings and will advise the school on science teaching-learning. S/he will also play a major role in promoting and nurturing the vision of DPKI as a hub of knowledge and intellectual growth.
