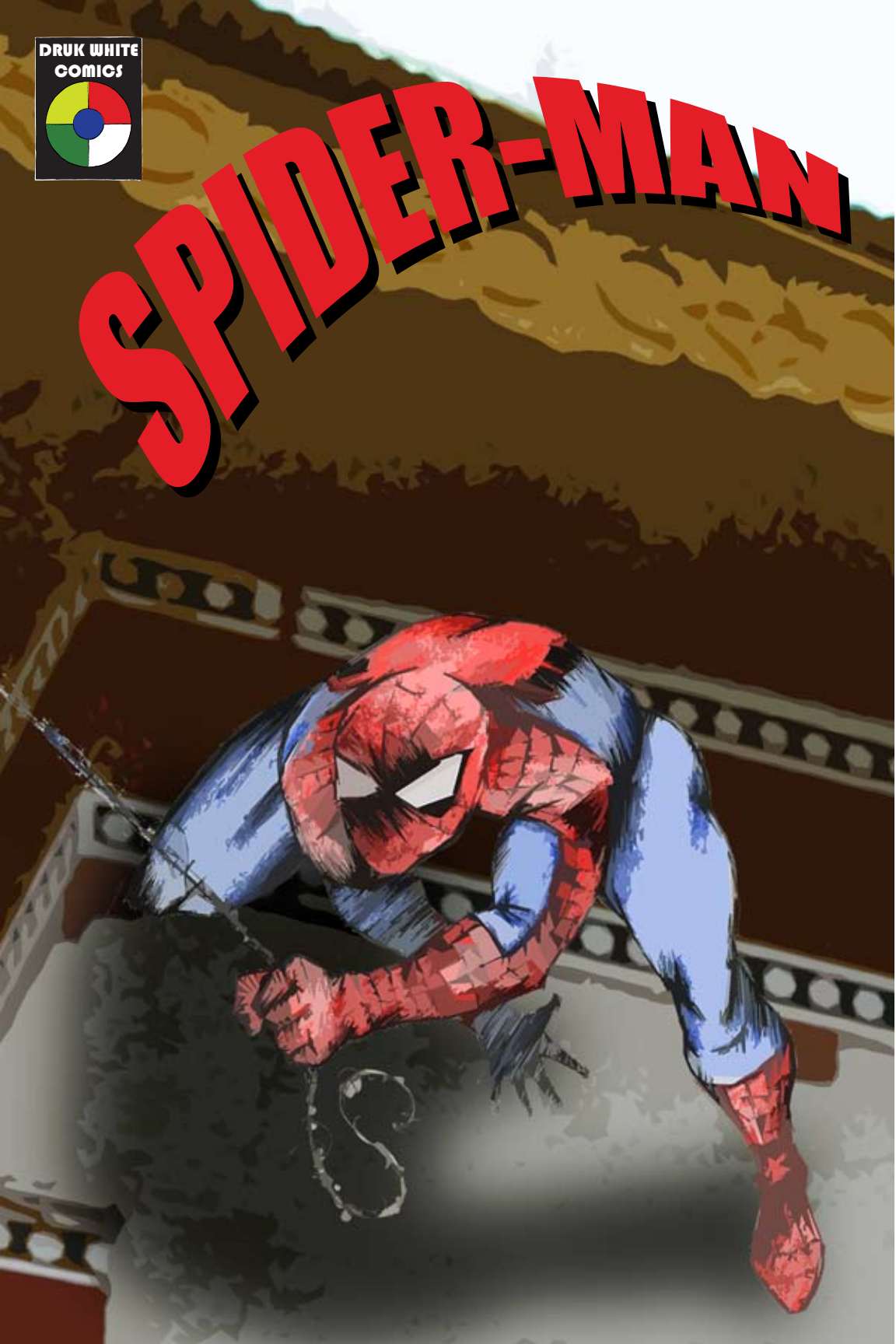




SPIDER-MAN

Ok Spidey!

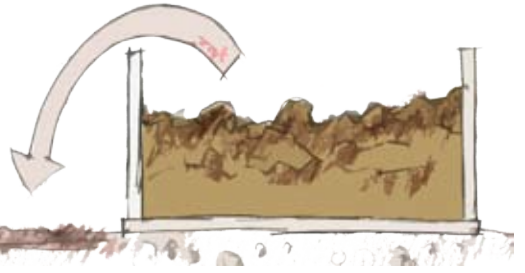
When composting you can only use organic material like left over rice or banana peels. There should not be any plastics or metal. They will not decompose and turn into dirt.

Every couple days you have to turn the compost to allow for air to move through the compost. The sun, air, and a little moisture will do much of the work. However, the process still needs our attention.

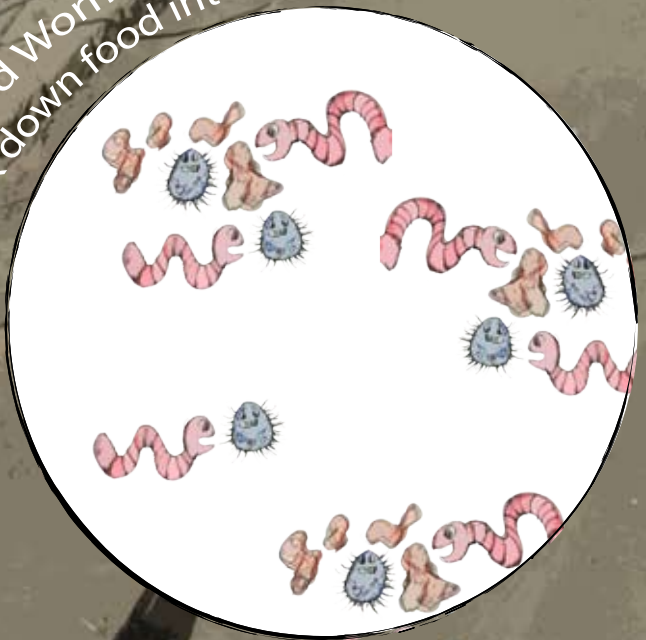
What else helps my leftovers to decompose.

Bacteria and Worms will all help to break down food into dirt

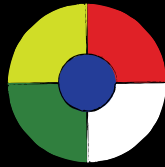


The now empty compost bin can be filled once again to be turned back into usable garden soil.
